NEW BUS AND COACH TRANSPORT INFORMATION FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS:

Date: Thursday 12th and Friday 13th of January 2017

There is a new traffic management plan in place for the BT Young Scientist & Technology Exhibition for 2017. Due to increasing numbers attending each year and the high volumes of traffic that are in the area of the RDS we are putting in place a company to manage the pick up and drop off points for bus/coaches that are bringing students to the event. It is important that you read the information and give the details to the coach driver on the day that you are attending in the RDS.

Route: From Merrion Road turn onto Anglesea Road and travel to the Anglesea Gate, of the RDS.

Gate D – Anglesea Road

Arrival Times 08:30- 10:30

Coaches/buses will be allowed to pull into the Anglesea Gate (D) of the RDS and they will be allowed to park for 5 minutes to allow the teachers and students to disembark the coach. COACHES ARE NOT PERMITTED to stay longer than 5 minutes or park in this location.

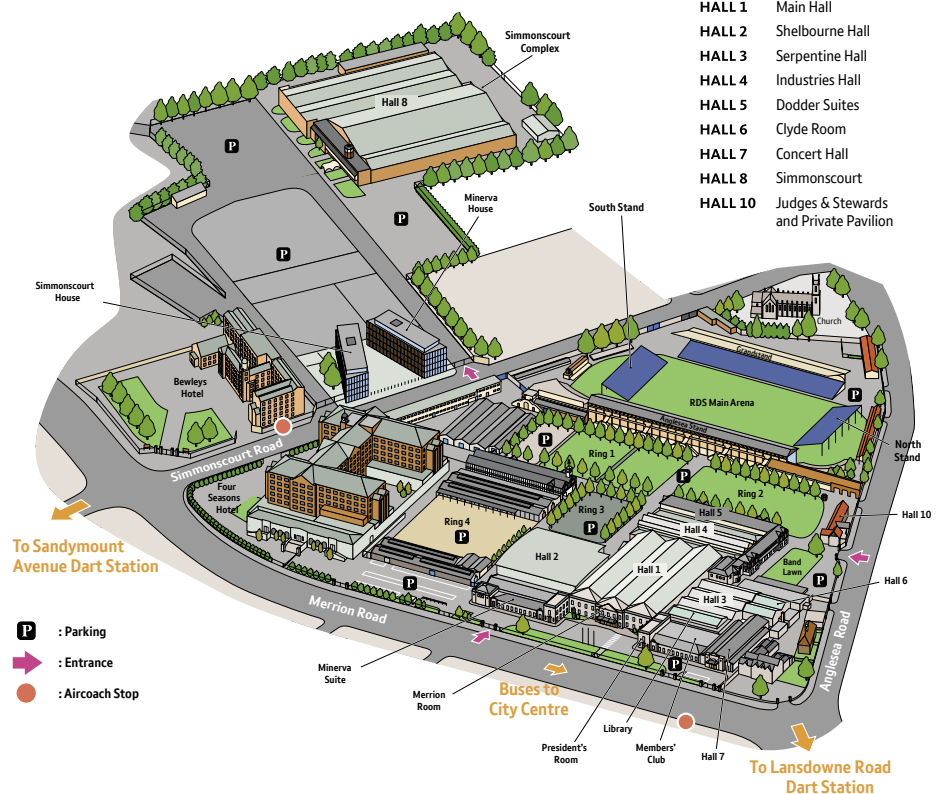
Once the bus/coach is empty it will be directed to depart via Gate L onto the Simmonscourt Road.

Return Pick Location from 14:30- 16:00

Please arrive back to the Anglesea Gate (D) of the RDS where you will be permitted entry to the pick up area once it is confirmed that your school group are ready to depart. Once you gain entry to the RDS at Gate D you will be permitted 10 minutes to load passengers back on board and then depart via Gate L onto the Simmonscourt Road.

Please take note of the following:

- Please follow the instructions of the Garda and Transport personnel on the day.
- Please ensure that the bus driver understands the location that you are to be dropped off and does not drop you off in any other location around the RDS, as you may have a long walk with your students to the meeting point.
- Please ensure that the driver only returns to pick you school up at the time you are ready to depart, it will not be possible for the bus to be parked for longer than 10 minutes at the pick up location.
- There is no coach/bus parking permitted on Anglesea Road or Simmonscourt Road. Clamping enforcement will be in operation for these vehicles around the RDS.
- There is some limited Coach Parking Spaces available, which will be allocated on a first come first served basis in the Simmonscourt Area of the RDS, with entry through gate M (Embassy Gate).
